These are four impressive offerings from this Napa winery, but all are limited in quantity (89 cases of the Grenache and 100-200 of each Syrah). The **2004 Grenache Sage Canyon Vineyard** exhibits a dark ruby color as well as classic aromas of strawberries, jammy cherries, earth, roasted herbs, and spice. Medium-bodied, juicy, and succulent, it is best consumed over the next 4-5 years. The dark ruby/purple-tinged **2004 Syrah Brookside Vineyard** reveals a young, exuberant nose of blackberries, raspberries, and earth. Tightly-knit with good tannin, medium to full body, and crisp acidity, it requires another year or so of bottle age to unfurl, but it possesses impressive potential.

Revealing a slightly deeper ruby/purple color, the medium to full-bodied **2004 Syrah Castle Rock Vineyard** offers a floral component along with blacker fruits (blueberries and blackberries) in its cool-climate, more complex nature. This high-class Syrah needs 1-2 years of bottle age, and should evolve beautifully for 10-12 years. Displaying the inkiest ruby/purple color, the **2004 Syrah Sage Canyon Vineyard** exhibits sweet aromas of blueberries, blackberries, licorice, earth, and a notion of spring flowers. This is the most plush and opulent of these cuvees, no doubt because of its higher glycerin level. It should drink well for 7-8 years. Tel. and Fax (707) 254-9727
